The City of Cambridge has instituted a policy governing permits for use of fields and/or parks.
-Proof of residency must be provided to the satisfaction of the City of Cambridge
-Permits are nontransferable
-Approved Permits shall be used for designated areas only
-Events must remain open to the General Public, Admission fees cannot be charged on City of Cambridge parks, fields or open space areas
-The following are prohibited in parks/fields or open space areas: use of alcohol, drugs, firearms, fireworks, cooking or making fire, littering, undue noise, soliciting or roping off fields
-Cambridge School Dept and other City agency activities must be allowed to finish their activities before permittees may use the park/field.
-The City of Cambridge reserves the right to revoke permits or change schedules
-Person(s) or Organization(s) permitted to use facilities shall protect the property from abuse and shall be responsible for any damage occurred in connection with or in consequence with such use. Such Person(s) and/or Organization(s) shall be responsible for the behavior of person(s) attending and shall furnish if necessary, at their own expense, fire, police detail or other protection as the City of Cambridge may direct.
-A copy of the permit must be shown to representatives of the City of Cambridge upon request.
-Each reserved time slot is 2 hours long, beginning at the start time specified.
-For Danehy Park/St Peters Field permits, in the event of inclement weather, please call (617) 349-4895 for possible cancelations.
-Teams which leave litter/debris on the field or area after their game will be fined a minimum fee of \$200.00 for cleaning. The permit will be suspended until the fine is paid.

Effective June 1, 2015, smoking is not allowed on City of Cambridge permitted athletic fields and BBQ/Picnic areas.
